ECFA'S 7TH ANNUAL BENEFIT AUCTION RECAP

ECFA's 7th Annual Benefit Auction on November 22nd at the Marriott Milwaukee West was an enjoyable time with 147 people attending in person and 11 others who participated virtually. There were 58 individuals new to the auction and 33 completely new to ECFA.

The guests enjoyed a wonderful assortment of appetizers and desserts.
