HIS PLANS PREVAIL

International travel for adoptive families basically has been “on hold” since the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic. ECFA is extremely grateful that two children from China were able to meet their adoptive families and travel to their “forever” homes just before the Covid crisis began in 2020.

Likewise, as the current Ukrainian crisis unfolds, God, in His sovereignty and mercy, allowed three Ukrainian children to join their ECFA forever families in the past several months.

Andrey, age 12, joined the West family of six, which includes four siblings. He resided in the Charity Center, a Christian orphanage in Central Ukraine, prior to his placement with the family. The Wests had hosted Andrey in their home in the past. They continued to communicate with him via videoconference calls during all of Covid. When they were reunited in Ukraine, Andrey felt as if

he had always been a part of their family.

Based on what Andrey has shared, the adoptive parents are confident that he feels as if he belongs in their family and is secure in his new home. Please pray for Andrey’s continued adjustment and for the Charity Center, which continues to care for numerous orphans in Ukraine. The Center has recently extended their ministry to serving refugees as well.

Within the past six months, Kate, age 16, and Daniel, age 17, joined the Fromstein family of four, which includes a younger sister and brother. The teens resided in an orphanage in Ukraine prior to their placement with the Fromsteins. The family had hosted them in their home in the past. They kept in touch via phone calls and FaceTime, and openly discussed potential adoption with them since their initial hosting visit in their home.

Kate and Daniel’s adjustment is going very well for all family members. Kate is so grateful for the opportunity to be living in the United States. She is taking advantage of every opportunity she is being given without taking anything for granted.
