ECFA's 41st Anniversary Celebration

After another year of faithful ministry, ECFA held its 41st Anniversary Celebration by hosting brunch at the Marriott Milwaukee West Hotel in Waukesha. Thanks to the generosity of attendees and sponsors, the event raised \$16,836.95 in net income to support ECFA's ongoing services to children and families.
